### IMPORTANT INFORMATION

\* **CAMPING UNDER TREES IS AT YOUR OWN RISK.**

\* **CHECK OUT**  
Check out time is 10am. If you wish to extend your booking, please let reception know before this time.

\* **POWER POINTS**  
One (1) Power Point per Site  
Keep ALL vehicles, tents, boats, pegs, ropes in marked area.

\* **SPEED LIMIT**  
The campground roads are shared and the speed limit is 5km/hr.

\* **WATER POINTS & TIMES**  
Due to water restrictions, boats must be washed at the local boat ramps and cars/caravans be washed at the local car wash.

\* **NOISE/PARTYING POLICY**  
All loud noise MUST cease by 10pm. Use of generators is NOT permitted. Vehicles cannot be run for any length of time to charge batteries or other equipment.

\* **STRICTLY NO DRONES**  
The campground is located in a flight path and operates helicopter flights from the premises, therefore making drones dangerous to operate.

\* **PLEASE ALSO NOTE:**  
- No campfires  
- Please store your valuables in a safe place.  
- Cancellation Policy - all bookings are non-refundable.  
- Drawbars must be facing the road.
